DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its label.

APPLICATION FOR OUTDOOR TREATMENT OF SPOTTED LANTERNFLY

Use this product by application as a perimeter treatment, spray or broadcast application to exterior surfaces of buildings, lawns, grounds, and ornamental plantings.

Apply as a mist or coarse low-pressure spray at the rate of 0.25 to 1.5 fl oz of this product per 1,000 sq ft of surfaces. Apply in a sufficient volume of water to provide adequate coverage but do not allow run-off to occur.

APPLICATION RESTRICTIONS

Do not water the treated area to the point of run-off.

Do not make applications during rain.

Do not apply directly to impervious horizontal surfaces such as sidewalks, driveways, and patios except as a spot, pin stream, or crack and crevice treatment.

During application, do not allow pesticide to enter or run off into storm drains, drainage ditches, gutters, or surface waters.

All outdoor applications, if permitted elsewhere on the product label, must be limited to spot, pin stream, or crack and crevice treatments only, except for the following permitted uses:

- 1. Applications to soil or vegetation, as listed on this label, around structures;
- 2. Applications to lawns, turf, and other vegetation, as listed on this label;
- 3. Applications to the side of a building, up to a maximum height of 3 feet above grade;
- 4. Applications to underside of eaves, soffits, doors, or windows permanently protected from rainfall by a covering, overhang, awning, or other structure:
- 5. Applications around potential pest entry points into buildings, when limited to a surface band not to exceed one inch in width;
- 6. Applications made through the use of a coarse, low pressure spray to only those portions of surfaces that are directly above bare soil, lawn, turf, mulch or other vegetation, as listed on this label, and not over an impervious surface, drainage or other condition that could result in runoff into storm drains, drainage ditches, gutters, or surface waters, in order to kill occasional invaders or aggregating pests.

Application is prohibited directly into sewers or drains, or to any area like a gutter where drainage to sewers, storm drains, water bodies, or aquatic habitat can occur. Do not allow the product to enter any drain during or after application.

Do not apply Suspend PolyZone through any type of irrigation system.

Do not apply this product to edible crops.

WHERE TO APPLY

- Apply directly to insects that have congregated around doors, window frames, and similar areas where they may enter the structure.
- Apply a perimeter treatment as described above.
- For best results, treat trees and shrubs infested with Spotted Lanternfly early in the season. Tree spraying may require ornamental license check with your local regulator.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is extremely toxic to fresh water and estuarine fish and invertebrates. Use with care when applying in areas adjacent to any body of water. To protect the environment, do not allow pesticide to enter or run off into storm drains, drainage ditches, gutters, or surface waters. Applying this product in calm weather when rain is not predicted for the next 24 hours will help to ensure that wind or rain does not blow or wash pesticide off the treatment area. Rinsing application equipment over the treated area will help avoid run off to water bodies or drainage systems.

This pesticide is highly toxic to bees exposed to direct treatment. Do not apply or allow it to drift to crops or weeds on which bees are actively foraging.
